

The warehouse is beginning to look like this!

Last week we received in donations 847k and gave out
2423k feeding 225 clients on 122 vouchers

We are still waiting for the bank to register our new name
and discovered last week that the bank has mislaid our
papers and the process needs to start from scratch
again. Unbelievable
