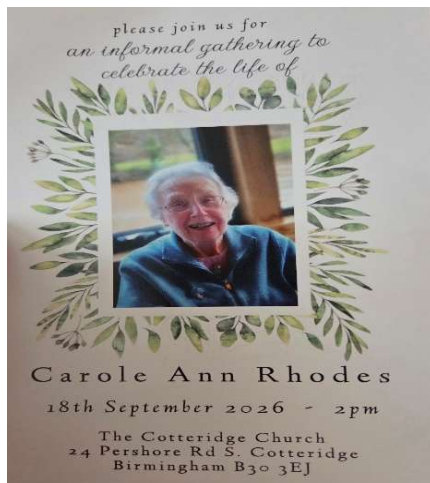


Celebration of life

If you would like to make a contribution or if you'd like to personally arrange some then please speak to Sandra W.

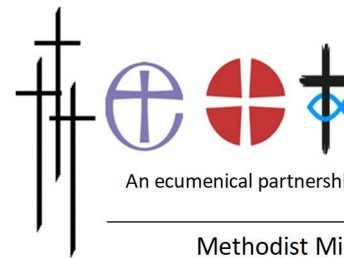
Christmas planning group
